

**Regulation for the assignment of total or partial coverage scholarships for students of
the Master in "Planning and Management of Transportation and Logistic Systems"
Academic year 2007/08**

Art. 1

This document regulates the assignment of scholarships to students of the Master in "Planning and Management of Transportation and Logistic Systems", that will cover the enrolment fee totally or partially.

Scholarships are to be assigned partly to citizens from the European Union and partly to any other citizens from all around the world as follow:

- A) all the candidates admitted to the Master: 4 scholarships of € 4.000,00 each;
- B) all the candidates admitted to the Master except Italians : 5 grants of € 6.000,00 each and 2 grants of € 4.000,00 each;
- C) all the candidates admitted to the Master from India: 4 grants of € 8.000,00 each.

Further available scholarships will be assigned by the Teachers Committee.

Scholarships not assigned in one of the A), B) and C) groups will be available for candidates in the other one, at sole discretion of the Teachers Committee, except for the scholarships funded by the "Invest Your Talent in Italy" program which is reserved to Indian citizens.

Art. 2

The call is open to all candidates that have submitted an admission form for the Master in "Planning and Management of Transportation and Logistic Systems" - academic year 2007/08 - by the terms provided for in the 3845 Rectoral Decree (26th June 2007) and that have been admitted to the Master.

Scholarships will be assigned by the Teachers Committee, with the potential participation of the companies funding the scholarships, taking into account the candidate resume, the candidate introduction letter, an interview (also via conference call) with the Teachers Committee if necessary, and other criteria set by the Teachers Committee.

Art. 3

If a scholarship winner renounces to his enrolment to the Master, the scholarship will be assigned to the candidate with the highest following score in the list.

Art. 4

Scholarships cannot be combinable with other scholarships or student loans.

Art. 5

The winners of a scholarship for an amount:

- equal to € 6.000,00: will have to pay the part of the enrolment fee not covered by the scholarship (€ 2.000,00) by 14th December 2007 and according to the conditions indicated in the 3845 Rectoral Decree (26th June 07);

- equal to € 4.000,00: will have to pay the part of the enrolment fee not covered by the scholarship (€ 4.000,00) by 14th December 2007 and according to the conditions indicated in the 3845 Rectoral Decree (26th June 07).

Art. 6

The winners list will be made available at the Course Administrative Secretariat and on the Perform's website (www.perform.unige.it) together with the admission list and with the deadline scheduled by the 3845 Legislative Decree (26th June 07). In particular:

- 1) By 23rd November 07: not Italian winners;
- 2) By 7th December 07: Italian winners.

Art. 7

The participation at the scholarship allocation call involves the acceptance of this regulation.

Art. 8

In addition to the scholarships indicated by this regulation, contributions for the Genoa stay expenses will be given to the Master admitted candidates. The contributions assignment conditions will be detailed in a following communication.
